Admission Requirements

We are seeking motivated and passionate individuals who meet the following criteria:

- Academic Qualifications (Essential): Completion of high school or equivalent with a strong academic record. If you are a last year senior high school student, you can get a conditional offer subject to the submission of your certified diploma before the official enrolment.
- Personal Statement (Essential): A written statement detailing your interest in the programme and career aspirations.
- Letters of Recommendation (Desirable): Two letters from academic or professional references.
- Certified copy of English language (Essential)

Please note that based on the domestic legislation in force eligible candidates are:

1. Graduates of high schools or equivalent schools that are physically based abroad. If they have attended the last two (2) grades of high school or equivalent school in a foreign country, they must present a high school diploma or other equivalent secondary education qualification entitling them to admission to higher education institutions in the country in which they graduated.

2. Graduates of a recognised foreign school of other EU member states or third countries legally established and operating in Greece, whose qualification entitles them to admission to higher education institutions located in the country whose educational curriculum is followed by the foreign school of graduation, provided that: b) they and their parents do not have Greek citizenship and b) they have fully attended at least the last two (2) grades of high school.

Application Process

Interested candidates are encouraged to apply by following these steps:

1. Online Application: Complete the online application form available on our website https://philosophy-business.uniwa.gr/admissions/

2. Submit Documents: Upload your academic transcripts, personal statement, English Certificate and letters of recommendation.

3. Online Interview: Shortlisted candidates may be invited for an interview (virtual).

- Interview Period: 20-25 July 2025
- Programme Start Date: Early October 2025 (exact date TBA)

Essential Documents to be submitted:

- 1. Completed online Application form.
- 2. CV in English
- 3. For already graduates: Senior High School Graduation Certificate. For those who are still studying: Final year academic transcript or midyear School Report. In case the transcripts are not in English a certified copy of English translation is needed. Candidates will be admitted if they have obtained at least a pass mark in their final year of secondary school.
- Certificate of competency in English (not required for native speakers): English language proficiency certificate at B2 level or ILTS score > 5.5 (or equivalent) or TOEFL score > 79/120
- 5. Letter of Personal Statement in English
- 6. Copy of a valid Passport
- 7. One (1) photo (small)

Submission of an application for this call does not imply any acceptance. According to our regulations these documents should be also submitted in hard copy to our registry office upon your arrival.

Before Submitting your application:

At this stage, you must have certified your original documents and their official translation into English. You can do this, by having the Apostille attached to them, if your country is a member of the Hague Apostille Convention.

Find Apostille countries in <u>https://www.hcch.net/en/states/hcch-members</u>, or by having them notarized by a Notary Public (Notarial Certificates). Alternatively, by having them attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs /or the Ministry of Education of the issuing country.

Following your initial application, you will obtain an application ID. Please keep your application ID for future reference.

The Admission Office will then:

- check your credentials
- assess your overall grade against the general performance criterion
- inform you about your eligibility for admission to the program

We are committed to consider strong applications, seeking promising and dedicated students who will contribute to our community. For this reason, there is an application fee of 100€ paid via bank transfer, after transaction costs, to the Research Committee account in Alpha Bank: **GR7001401510151002001006943**. This amount will be offset only to those candidates who will ultimately enrol the program.

In case your application is initially successful & Payment methods:

- Non-EU students pay in advance the full amount of first year's fees, that is 6,000€, free of bank charges.
- If you are required to get a student Visa and your application is turned down, you will get a full refund before transaction costs.
- For citizens of the European Union, we offer flexible payment plans (up to three instalments), allowing you to spread the cost over both semesters.
- Please contact the local Consular Office of the Embassy of Greece in order to submit your visa application and biometric data on time.
- Health insurance: You should have arranged for private health insurance, covering your stay in Greece during your studies before you can enrol in the program. Please contact the admissions office in order to guide you with tailored made solutions explicitly designed for our students at a low cost.
